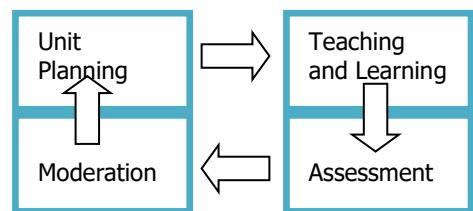

Most subjects are taught in 10 week blocks with an assessment piece at the end of the teaching. Assessment pieces are moderated within the year level to ensure consistency within our teaching and learning framework.
