### **Instruction 1: Intune Device Enrolment**

#### Introduction

Intune is a secure mobile management system that allows you to use school Wi-Fi, emails, learning applications and websites on personal devices.

These instructions will show you how to enrol a BYO Windows device into Intune and install an application. This process may take up to 15 minutes to complete.

Before you start, please have ready the email address and password that has been supplied to you by the school. If you do not have this information, you will not be able to successfully complete the installation. Please contact your school to obtain these details.

These instructions are for Windows 11 and above. You may find some of the screens look different to the ones provided here if you have an older version of Windows or there are changes made to Intune.

If the installation fails at any time, please re-open the Intune app and try again.

Please note: If you have any problems with installing Intune or using it afterwards, please contact IT@buderimmountainss.eq.edu.au for assistance. See below for troubleshooting and Intune FAQ's.


#### Instructions

#### Step 1. Install Intune

a. Connect to the internet and select the Windows icon at the bottom of your screen




b. Select the Settings icon





#### c. Select Accounts



d. Select Access work or school. If your account is already listed, select it and then select Disconnect. Then select Connect.





e. Enter your school @eq.edu.au email address and select Next.

### Set up a work or school account

You'll get access to resources like email, apps, and the network. Connecting means your work or school might control some things on this device, such as which settings you can change. For specific info about this, ask them.

Remember sign-in info?


Let Windows remember your sign-in name and password so you don't have to.

Stored sign-in info can be used with other apps as well (so you won't need to enter it again), and it's automatically synced to all your PCs.



Step 2. Install Company Portal and BYOx Mapper apps

a. Select the **Windows Start menu** and open the **Microsoft Store** app. Search for **Company Portal** application and install it.

## Instruction 2: Download and install Microsoft Office 365 Applications

#### **Important Information**

This is not available to download from the School network, it must be done from home.

#### Instructions

Step 1:

- a. Open internet browser and navigate to <u>https://office.com</u>
- b. **Click** on "Sign in" and enter students username. **Type** in your EQ (e.g. <u>ismith1@eq.edu.au</u>) email address and **click** "next".


#### Step 2:

a. You will be prompted for your username and password on the online authentication page. Type your username and password. Ensure just to use the username and not @eq.edu.au.

- b. Click Login
- c. In the top right corner, click on the Install apps then Premium Microsoft 365 apps.



- d. A pop-up message will appear prompting you to run or save the .exe file.
- e. Click on 'Save'. The file will automatically begin to download.

f. When the file has completed downloading, **click** on 'Run'. You can also open your computers Downloads folder and 'Run' the setup file there.

Please note this file may take a while to download depending on your bandwidth speed.

g. You will be prompted with a message to make changes to your computer. Select 'Yes'.



h. Microsoft 365 will start downloading and install onto your computer, wait for this to finish.



i. After Microsoft 365 finishes installing, a message will appear to inform it has completed. **Click** 'Close'.



j. After you click close, we recommend restarting your computer to ensure all changes have applied successfully.

When you start an Office app for the first time you'll be prompted to sign in to Office to Activate. Be sure to sign in using your @eq.edu.au (school account).

Your Microsoft Office 365 software is now ready for you to use. This software is only for personal devices and will remain available as long as you're a Queensland state school member. This software can be installed on up to 5 devices (Windows/Apple). See below for troubleshooting steps.



## **Troubleshooting Steps**

#### Step 1: Ensure your child's account has computer Administration privileges

**Important Information:** Laptop Administration rights will be required to install school-based network printers and applications. If parental controls are enforced on your child's account, we strongly recommend creating an additional "BMSS Admin" account and giving this user name and password to the Teacher who can use this when required.

#### Check to ensure Administration rights is enabled for your child's account

#### 1: Click Start Menu > Settings

#### 2: Click Accounts > Other users

3: Ensure your Childs account set to **Administrator – Local account**. If not, select Change account type to Administrator

#### Step 2: Ensure Windows S Mode is switched off

**Important Information:** To ensure compatibility with BMSS BYO program devices must be switched out of Windows 10/11 S Mode to run school-based applications. Some applications include Microsoft 365 suite, mBlock, LEGO EV3, Scratch Desktop, Kodu and network printers.

- 1. On your PC running Windows 10 in S mode, open Settings > Update & Security > Activation.
- 2. In the **Switch to Windows 10 Home** or **Switch to Windows 10 Pro** section, select **Go to the Store**. (If you also see an "Upgrade your edition of Windows" section, be careful not to click the "Go to the Store" link
- 3. that appears there.)
- 4. On the **Switch out of S mode** (or similar) page that appears in the Microsoft Store, select the **Get** button. After you see a confirmation message on the page, you'll be able to install apps from outside of the

## Intune FAQ's

What can school administration staff see or not see on my child's device?

#### Can I have multiple mobile device management tools on my child's device?

Microsoft Intune does not work if other mobile device management (MDM) tools are installed on the device.

#### Can I use parental controls if my child's device has Intune installed?

Parental controls can be used in conjunction with Intune. Windows has <u>Microsoft Family</u> to manage screen time and block and manage apps and features on your child's device. For iOS, <u>refer to parental controls on your child's</u> <u>iPhone</u>, <u>iPad and iPod touch</u> to explore a range of iOS parental control features.

#### Is there any cost associated with using Intune?

There is no cost for your child to use Intune and Microsoft Office 365.
