99.4% of BMSS students achieved a 'C' or above for their work effort and engagement in classroom learning



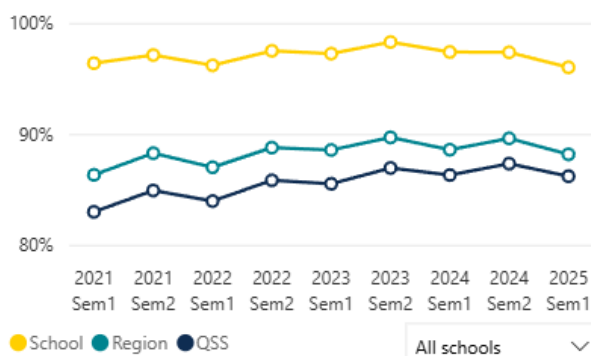
861 students received an 'A' for excellent effort in Mathematics

2025 % of students achieving a 'C' or above for English from Prep to Year 6 - 96%

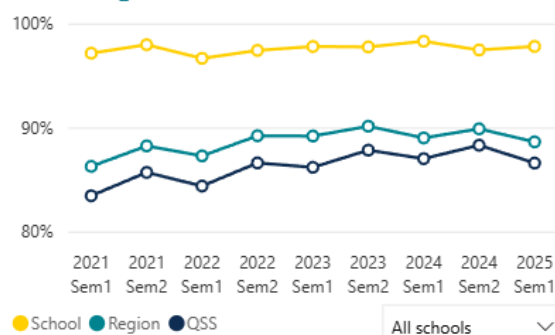
Percentage of selected results

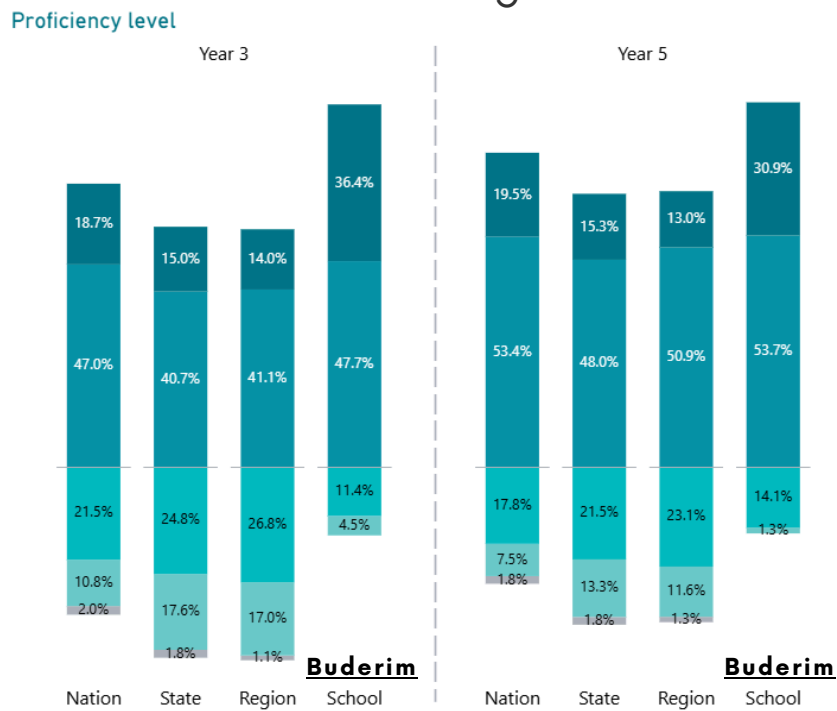

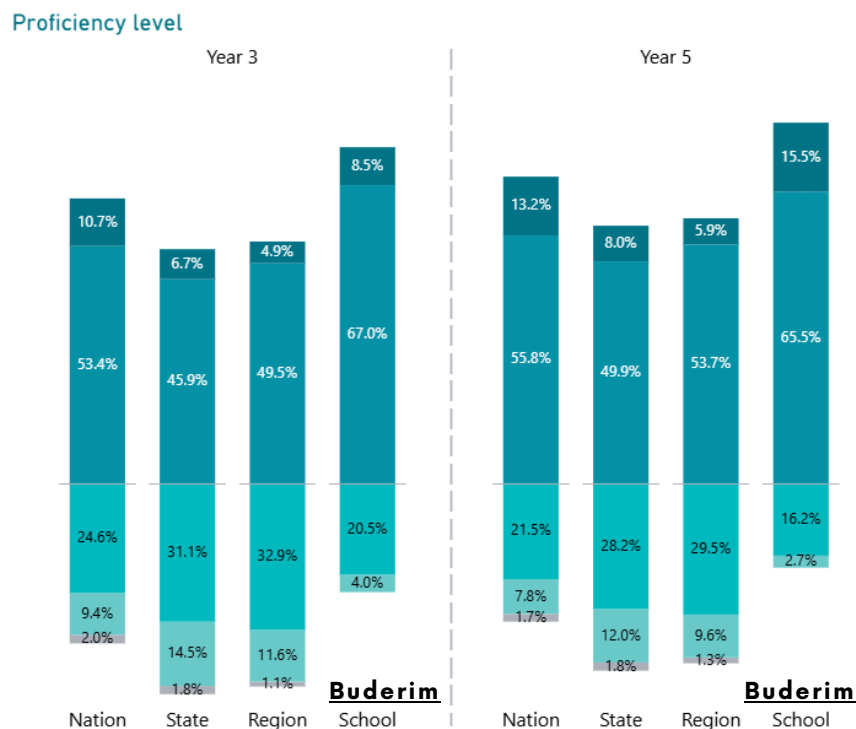
NAPLAN

The National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) is a series of standardised tests focused on the Australian Curriculum skills reading, writing, language (spelling, grammar and punctuation) and numeracy in Years 3, 5, 7 and 9. Students at BMSS consistently achieve outstanding results on the NAPLAN tests and we are consistently placed well above national achievement averages in all tests. 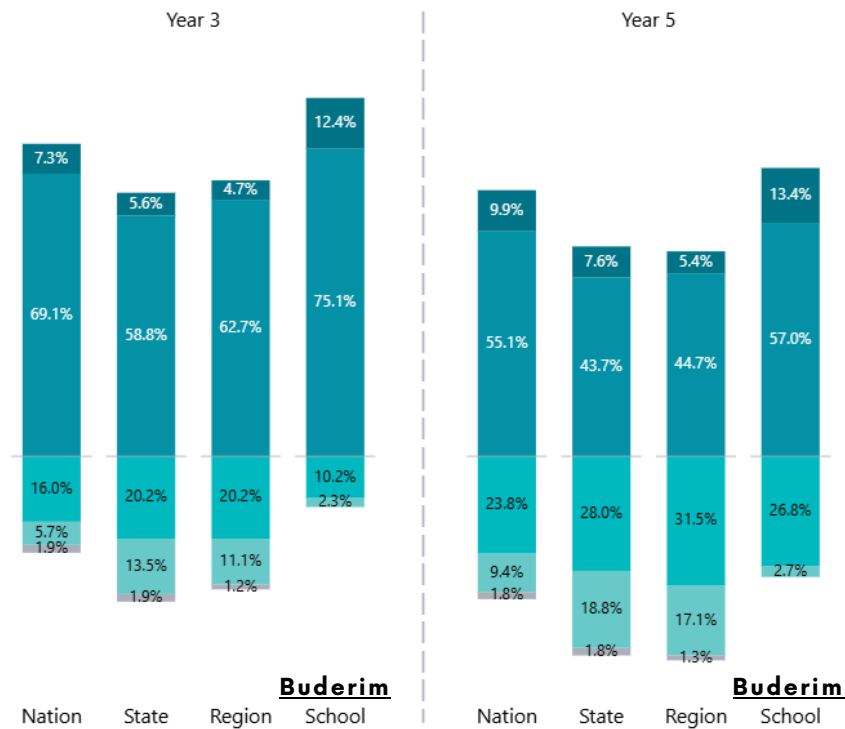

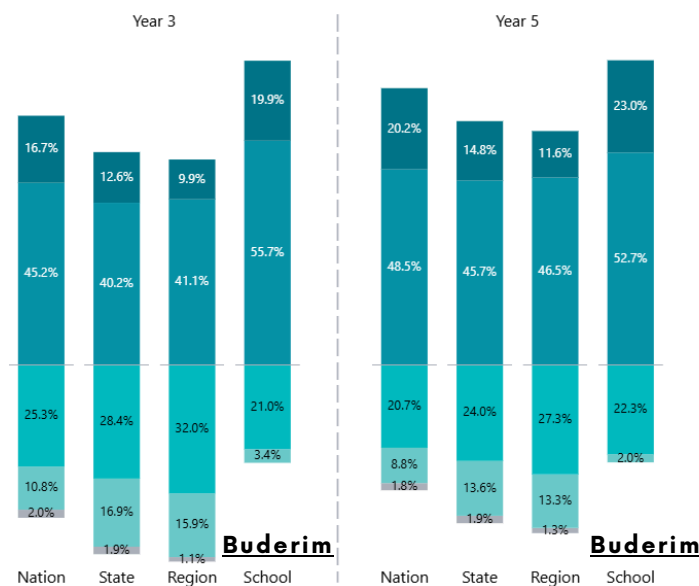
