This funding will be used to

- Assist all students to achieve the National Minimum Standard in National Testing.
- Assist all students to achieve the internal BMSS literacy and numeracy targets for each year level.
- Aim for the number of students who achieve in the Upper Two Bands in National Testing to be above the State and National average.

Our initiatives include

- Employment and training of additional teacher aides and support teachers in all Prep- Year 6 classrooms to support students and teachers in the implementation of literacy and numeracy blocks to cater for all ability levels.
- Implementing a tutoring program focused on literacy improvement for identified students.
- Revising the current internal data collection items linked (Assessment Plan) and providing release time for teachers to engage in structured data analysis, sharing of expertise and consistency of curriculum and assessment implementation.
- Providing access to additional literacy and numeracy resources as a differentiation strategy for students.
- Providing additional professional development to teacher aides in supporting student literacy development.
- Continuing to develop teachers' expertise and capacity with the implementation of literacy and numeracy blocks.
- Implementing strategies to maximise student attendance.
- Increasing the employment of a chaplain to support students with building resilience and providing support as needed.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employing additional teacher aides to provide targeted support in classrooms \$130 000
- Employing additional teachers to provide targeted support for high achieving students \$60 000
- Purchasing additional literacy and numeracy resources \$20 000
- Employing a chaplain for additional days \$25 000
- Providing release time for teachers to assist with individual student data collection and analysis \$51 217
- Employing an administration officer to follow up and monitor student absences \$15 000
