Under this agreement for 2022 Buderim Mountain State School will receive

\$297,433*

This funding will be used to

- Assist all students to achieve the National Minimum Standard in National Assessment Program - Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN).
- Assist all students to achieve the internal Buderim Mountain State School literacy and numeracy targets for each year level.
- Aim for the number of students who achieve in the Upper Two Bands in National Testing to be above the State and National average.

Our initiatives include

- Employment and training of additional teacher aides and support teachers in all Prep- Year 6 classrooms to support students and teachers in the implementation of literacy and numeracy blocks to cater for all ability levels.
- Implementing a tutoring program focused on literacy improvement for identified students.
- Implementing the current Assessment Plan and providing release time for teachers to engage in structured data analysis, sharing of expertise and consistency of curriculum and assessment implementation.
- Providing access to additional literacy, numeracy and social emotional learning resources as a differentiation strategy for students.
- Continuing to develop teachers' expertise and capacity with the implementation of literacy and numeracy blocks through planning meetings and professional development.
- Implementing strategies to maximise student attendance.
- Increasing the employment of a chaplain to support students with building resilience and providing support as needed.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

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| • Employing additional teacher aides to provide targeted support in classrooms and to assist with follow up and monitoring of student absences | \$200 000 |
| • Providing professional development to improve teachers' expertise in literacy and numeracy blocks | \$ 20 000 |
| • Providing access to Social Emotional Learning lessons for all Prep-Year 6 students | \$ 15 000 |
| • Purchasing additional literacy and numeracy resources | \$ 35 000 |
| • Employing a chaplain for additional days | \$ 25 000 |
| • Providing release time for teachers to assist with year level team planning, individual student data collection and analysis | \$ 90 000 |
