This funding will be used to

- Assist all students to achieve the National Minimum Standard in National Testing.
- Assist all students to achieve the internal BMSS literacy and numeracy targets for each year level.
- Aim for the number of students who achieve in the Upper Two Bands in National Testing to be above the State and National average.

Our initiatives include

- Employment and training of additional teacher aides and support teachers in all Prep-Year 6 classrooms to support students and teachers in the implementation of literacy and numeracy blocks to cater for all ability levels.
- Implementing a tutoring program focused on literacy improvement for identified students.
- Implementing the current Assessment Plan and providing release time for teachers to engage in structured data analysis, sharing of expertise and consistency of curriculum and assessment implementation.
- Providing access to additional literacy, numeracy and social emotional learning resources as a differentiation strategy for students.
- Continuing to develop teachers' expertise and capacity with the implementation of literacy and numeracy blocks through planning meetings and professional development.
- Implementing strategies to maximise student attendance.
- Increasing the employment of a chaplain to support students with building resilience and providing support as needed.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employing additional teacher aides to provide targeted support in classrooms \$179 136 (including carry forward from 2020)
- Providing professional development to improve teachers' expertise in literacy and numeracy blocks
- Providing access to Social Emotional Learning lessons for all P-6 students \$15 000
- Purchasing additional literacy and numeracy resources \$35 000
- Employing a chaplain for additional days \$25 000
- Providing release time for teachers to assist with year level team planning, individual student data collection and analysis \$87 399

Employing an administration officer to follow up and monitor student absences \$17 200
